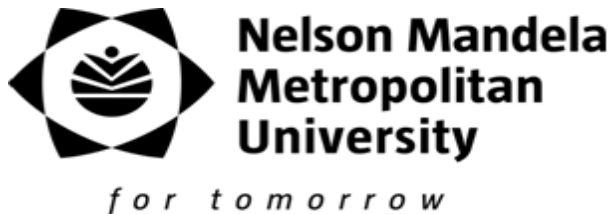




## ‘The 5<sup>th</sup> International Conference on Engineering, Project, and Production Management’
